

GOOGLE CALENDAR EMBED CODE RETRIEVAL FOR YOUR SITE

To embed a calendar, open up Google Calendar and log in to your school's account. Next go to the left-hand side and click on the little triangle next to the calendar you want to embed. You'll see an option box expand. Click on **Calendar Settings**.
